----- MEETING MINUTES -----

	Description				
1	North Branford Chairman Bigelow: extends welcome, reviews recent changes such as NBPCAG now has a full board of directors. They have provided equipment (players, hard drives, etc.) to North Branford High School. They have remedied a poor installation job related to studio hardware. Will be installed next Saturday. No public comments. Introduction of new member, Beth, currently the only BOE member of CASCC.				
2	Highlights: A letter from a senior in Northford concerned about program changes. Being 'forced' to digital and perception of being converted to a new service without consent. Letters related to the change in the TV Guide channel. R-J Editorial on Cable Services. The viewpoint most likely will be similar to letters to be expected based n most recent changes.				



3	Motion to accept 03/07 Minutes as -is, by John Elliot, seconded by Pete Garofalo. All in favor, no opposition, Beth
	abstains.
4	Treasurer Pete Garafolo: Earned \$75 in interest on CD, and only normal expenditures were made. Motion to accept treasurer's report made by John Elliot, seconded by Jeff Lincoln. All in favor, no oppositions or abstentions. Comcast check deposited.
5	John Bairos gave the Comcast Report. Available separately. Branford provided new sponsorship-underwriting program. Comcast was interested in reviewing further.
6	Deferred: Review of Comcast Survey results. As usual, education and arts programming are shown to be at the "about right" or at "too little" levels. CACSCC question results: 83.6% respondents aware of community channels. 70.7% report watching these channels. 18% report knowing people involved in community access. Results suggest those who watch public programming are tuning in for the quality and content of shows, not because they know someone involved. Only 34% were aware of the existence of the cable advisory council, suggesting steps should be taken to increase the public presence of this council. Only 18% report using the TV Guide channel to aid their selection of a show, although it should be noted that these results predate the relocation of the TV Guide Channel.
7	Confirmation of ACM membership for CACSCC/member towns has been acknowledged. Chairman Huizenga asks if members would be interesting in using the \$500 set aside for the annual program towards attending the Hartford training program and luncheon on September 15 th as this will be a 'training' event.
8	No public comments. Adjourn at 8:32 pm.
