## a. Welcome by BCTV President, Margo Hardenburgh and Branford Station Manager. Site report included: Station is fairly active including 1. a program getting some attention on NPR and in local press produced by local journalist Marsha Chambers who covers shoreline in Branford online newspaper (encouraged by advisors to have local producers submit to NE ACM Videofestival), 2. in discussion with AT&T for local launch of BCTV on U-verse in October using technology from Digital Rapids a competitor to local V-Brick option and 3. PEGPETIA grant submitted. b. Letters from customers including story of Wallingford subscriber that reported a Comcast technician approached in his truck said about DTV conversion in February: converter boxes will need to be rented to get any stations any TV if is analog.— All complaints were referred to Comcast. Questions were addressed by JB. D-TV document provided. See related document.

  - e. Comcast is available to give presentations on the transition at Sr. Centers in the area.
  - f. US Government has application process for a \$40.00 coupon for digital converter boxes-citizens should be encouraged to get the box and use coupon ASAP as they expire.
  - g. Mid-august issues with white noise audio in Madison, Branford and Wallingford. Technicians resolved.
- **a.** Library issue –WPAA could have been misrepresented by the producers. Need documentation on role of producer. "WPAA presents..." was a miscommunication. Library issue closed
